Guidelines

- The Council's recruiting and promotion center is a marketing committee resource. As such, its' purpose and use needs to be for promoting the Scouting program and our local Council.
- When displaying our program in public, we need to be proactive about the location selected for maximum effectiveness.
- This coordination should insure our center will have a respectable location and that adjacent displays not be in conflict with our message and be consistent with the Scout Oath and Law.
- While the canopy and banners are waterproof, they are not weatherproof. Even moderate
 winds (any wind greater than 10 mph) can do damage to the structure and banners. As such, it
 should not be counted on as shelter. The Base Camp must be secured on all corners at all
 times.
- "This center cannot be deployed without at least one Base Camp committee or Council professional taking responsibility".
- No Political Use, or other Use prohibited by BSA guidelines.





- Base Camp cannot be left unattended.
- The Scout uniform is the appropriate attire for Base Camp Staff.
- No food will be served to the public.
- No sales of unauthorized products (Council Popcorn and Nuts sales are permitted).
- No solicitation of donations (see National Fundraising Guide).
